FROM GO MONTH 2021

A JIHAD EX-NOVICE FOLLOWS CHRIST

A boy, about 8 years old, decided to follow Jesus. He lives in a country with high persecution rates and was a novice at a radical Islamic Jihadist camp until then.

He was used to memorize Islamic texts and later did the same with Bible scriptures. The boy visited Muslim families and answered their questions about God quoting scriptures in a way that amazed the families and some decided to follow Jesus.

SALVATION IN MUSLIM COUNTRIES

At our GO Pray event (page 4) we prayed for the harvest in predominantly Muslim countries. We later received reports telling us that many Muslims got saved. We were told that 15,000 people started a life with Christ in Chad. About 40,000 people received Christ in Indonesia and 336,000 in Sierra Leone. All of these people could never have been reached without the abundance of Christians devoted to God, like the 10,000 in Bangladesh.

SHARE THE GOSPEL WITH ONE

The Church of God was inspired to mobilize many churches of their denomination to commit to ONE A DAY — reaching out to someone every day. Together, as 260,000 Christians, they shared Jesus with 6.2 million people during GO Month. As a result 1.1 million people decided to follow Christ.

TRAINING IN PARTNERSHIP WITH EVANGELISM EXPLOSION

One of our speakers at GO Train was Evangelism Explosion's president John Sorensen, EE puts a lot of effort into teaching Christians how to share the Gospel. They told us that 98,144 Christians were trained for GO Month.





10,000 NEW CHURCHES

The GO Month released a hunger for more within the Redeemed Christian Church of God, one of the largest churches around the world. They have set themselves the goal of planting 10,000 churches to make disciples of the ones who decided for Christ through their evangelistic efforts as part of GO Movement.

PRAYER AND TRAINING

GO PRAY

On May 1st millions of believers around the world were praying for the harvest in a worldwide prayer meeting – World Prayer Together / GO PRAY, the International Prayer Connect organized the whole event.

The event was hosted by the International House of Prayer in Kansas City and broadcast on GODTV. The prayer meeting brought together millions of Christians worldwide with a special emphasis on prayer for China, India, and the Middle East. Prayer gatherings were carried out in many of the darkest places on earth in underground churches.





GO TRAIN

Prior to the GO Month, the GO Movement has hosted the first "GO Train" a worldwide virtual training session on April 24th broadcast on GOD TV and YouTube, to equip Christians for GO Month. More than 7 M Christians have been trained to share their faith in Russia alone, especially in these desperate times of chaos from the coronavirus pandemic where people are looking for hope.

Four experienced evangelists and speakers, Rick Warren (Saddleback Church), Werner Nachtigal (GO Movement), John Sorensen (Evangelism Explosion), and Mark Warder (Pulse) have equipped the viewers in personal evangelism with practical tips and personal encouragements.





Violent outbursts of gang violence were happening in the streets of Santo Domingo Este in the Dominican Republic. Not even the police could handle the situation but a pastor in the area felt the need to make a difference. Together with the GO Movement Coordinator he arranged a meeting between the gang bosses, pastors and a few members of the police. Instead of violent conflict they prayed, read the Bible and later signed a peace treaty.

They exchanged their weapons for Bibles and there are outreaches especially to win the gang members for Christ. And they do!

PUTTING AN END TO PROSTITUTION

Four years ago on GO Day a prostitute got saved and started a new life with Jesus. A Christian met her in the red-light district and gave her the amount of money she would get for her "services" in a day and sent her home. She had an encounter with God and started a new life.

This year, along with some pastors, **she invited 200 prostitutes to have dinner in public** to reach these young girls with the Gospel. Most of them didn't see another option; until then. After hearing the Gospel and the testimony of the former prostitute **twenty of the girls decided to start a new life with Christ** and were freed from prostitution both physically and spiritually. They are part of a local church now and work in new jobs. It's unbelievable and touching to see how God gives them a new life.

THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC HAS GOT 10.7 M INHABITANTS

About 45% of them are not Christian at all. This year 4.5 Million tracts were printed and spread (enough for 42% of the population).

6,000 of 7,000 churches were active during GO Month (300k Christians).



HE LOOKED LIKE A LIVING ZOMBIE

This man was homeless. He lived in Brazil and after several years of living on the streets, he began to look neglected; his appearance is reminiscent of that of a zombie.

"YOU CAN GO HOME AND DIE"

A Nepali Hindu man had terminal gastric cancer. He was in such bad shape that the doctors didn't think he had any chance to survive. So, they sent him home saying he could eat and do whatever he wanted to do in the last days or just hours of his life. Then two ordinary Christians came who were active in GO Month, and they repeatedly prayed for healing. And then that what the doctor's thought was impossible happened: The cancer was defeated, he decided to live with Jesus and now he preaches the Gospel wherever he goes.

THE HEALTHY DON'T NEED A DOCTOR, BUT THE SICK DO

A group of young Christians were praying in front of hospitals in Brazil. They were invited to enter the hospitals to pray for the sick in need of a miracle and were allowed to bring the message of peace and hope, which is the Gospel.

Christians found him and took care of him physically: They cut off his layers of old clothing with scissors, washed him and gave him new clothes. In the before and after images you see a fully transformed man.

He is integrated in a church now and starts his new life with the Lord.

UNITY IN THE MIDST OF WAR

Earlier this year, no one could have known just how bad the conflict in Israel would become. No one knew about the upcoming bombings and ground combat between Israel and Palestine. But many Christians felt the urge to pray for Israel, even before these incedents. Prayer for Israel and the Middle East were made a central part of the GO Pray / World Prayer Together event on May 1st.

As the war situation reached its peak Arabs and Jews met online to unite in prayer for their nation, and during the GO Month the Gospel has been shared in the midst of conflict.



CONGO CONFLICT

There is ongoing violence in the Democratic Republic of Congo. The attacks of rebel fighters and the protection of the military are making it a war zone.

A few Christians were able to share the Gospel with the military and as a result many of them decided to follow Christ.

COVID COULDN'T STOP INDIAN CHRISTIANS

War is not the only cause of suffering in our world. India has been hit by Covid extremely hard. There, Indian believers were going around to provide food to the poor, bury the dead bodies and at the same time share Jesus.

Whole families accepted Christ as their Lord and Savior. Many were baptized and some became missionaries to reach other parts of the country.

About 872,000 people were reached with the Gospel around GO Month. Approx. 87,000 of them decided to live with Christ.





ONE A DAY IN MAY

ONE A DAY ALL OVER LATIN AMERICA

The Church of God was inspired to mobilize many churches of their denomination to commit to ONE A DAY — reaching out to someone every day. Together, they shared Jesus with 6.2 million people during GO Month. As a result, 1.1 million people decided for Christ.

MEGACHURCH DOES ONE A DAY

Hector Cancino the pastor of a megachurch in Chile inspired 15,000 Christians to be part of ONE A DAY in May. They were so excited about it, that they decided to do it again... in November 2021.

INCREDIBLE SALVATIONS THROUGH ONE A DAY

Our African Continental Coordinator Stephen Mutua really embraced ONE A DAY. He went out to share the Gospel every day and he met more than one person each day resulting in 365 people not only hearing the Gospel but receiving Christ.

THE IDEA OF ONE A DAY

God has given the idea to Dave Gibson (GO Movement US Director) and of course he challenged the whole movement to reach ONE A DAY in May as well. At first glance it seems to be a challenge for experienced evangelists, and it was challenging, but many decided to take it regardless and inspired others to do so as well.

Kyle Lance Martin from Texas took the challenge and found a car with a raging alarm. He waited for the owner and talked to him. Kyle asked to pray for him, and they read through parts of the Bible. Something changed and the car owner said: "I felt something..." at home he prayed to experience God. He surrendered his life to Jesus and immediately texted Kyle. They are now in the process of discipleship.

We love how many people are reached, but it is about change in single lives.
