




What is the best gift you've EVER received?

It might seem a small thing, but it's a big deal. Heaven is basically out of the question.




Yes, but it comes at a price. The miracle is that someone paid that price for us - and that is the Easter story.

Apparently, someone out there loves us a lot more than we know.






He is the focus of Easter. His name is Jesus Christ.

Yet the impact of what He did is still being felt 2000 years later throughout the world.








Consider the things He did.


...are but a few of His miracles.


But most as tounding was that He rose from the dead on the third day (the Sunday).

Before His death His disciples ran for their lives. But after He had returned to life these same men willingly died for their belief - 10 of the 11 remaining disciples were executed for their beliefs, not to mention many thousands of others at that time.

People don't die for lies. They had seen Jesus alive again!

If it's true that Jesus did come to life again, then discovering Jesus is the very purpose for which we were born!


What has this got to do with EASTER?



Jesus died on that weekend in about A.D.30, which is what Easter is about. The gift of Easter is this:

A problem needed fixing: Our wrongs required a just punishment.

And God did it: In love Jesus took our punishment upon Himself. The sin-stained record of our wrongs can now be wiped clean simply by asking and trusting. By being clean again we are restored as God's friends, restored to our purpose as God's workers on earth to help others, and also restored to eternal life.



Yes there is! Its like you get given a free movie ticket with popcorn, but you have to actually watch the movie and eat the popcorn.

So it's free in the sense that there is nothing any of us can do to earn a clean record (no amount of good works can wipe the dirt stains of sin away).


But it's not just a 'ticket'. It's about being willing to turn back to God's plan for our lives, and Jesus' teachings explain what this is.



By asking with faith through a prayer like this:

Dear Lord Jesus, I believe you are the Son of God. Thank you for dying on the cross for my wrongs. Please forgive my wrongs and give me the gift of eternal life. Thank you that I am now your friend, and you are my heavenly 'Father'.

I commit to living my life by what you have told us in the Bible. Make me the kind of person you want me to be.



Then, to grow, Christians practice three key habits.

- 1. They read the **Bible** to understand what Jesus was like and how God wants them to live.
- They talk to God in prayer, seeking His blessing for others and His help in their lives so that they can live selflessly.
- 3. They attend a **Church** to learn about God from others and to have a few Christian **friends** so they can encourage each other in being faithful to God's ways.

It's like how a coal only stays hot when it is **IN** the fire. The habits strenghten faith.



So that is what Christians believe about Easter:

That God gave us an AMAZING gift...

A gift that is available to all who want it...
